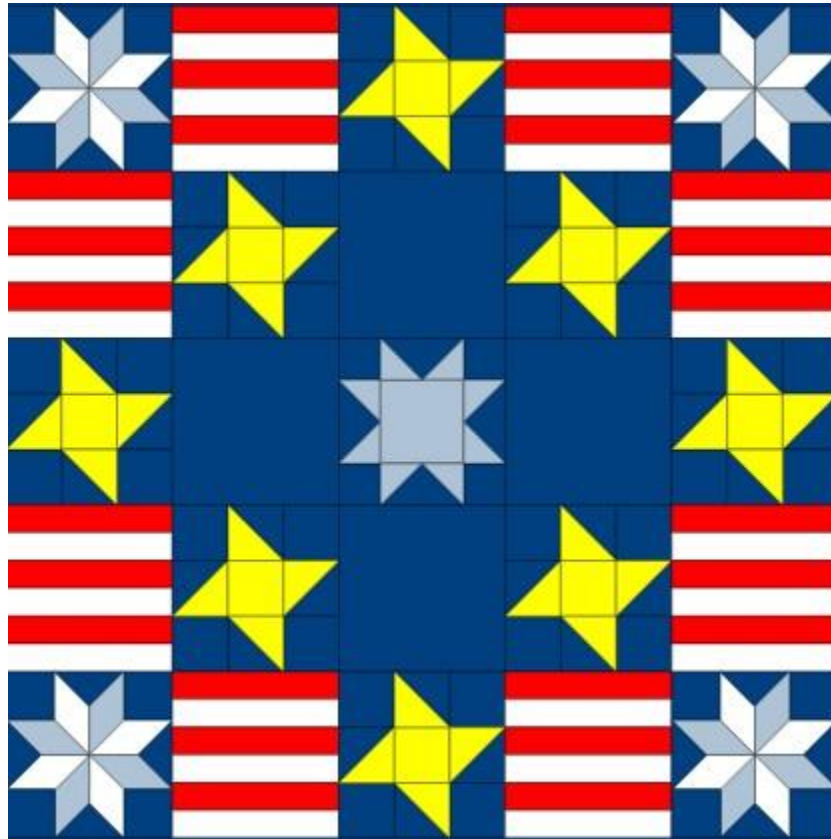


Noble Stars

Fabric Requirements

Blue (background)	1-3/4 yd	Yellow	1/2 yd
Light Blue	3/8 yd	White	1/4 yd
Red+White Stripes	1-1/8 yd		

True Blue *Quilts*



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Background - cut 4 squares at 12-1/2" for the negative spaces. Set aside.

Block 1 - Lazy LeMoyne Stars

Make 3-1/2" HSTs using the two-at-a-time method.

Cut 16 white squares, 16 light blue squares and 16 blue background squares at 3-7/8".

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white squares and two of the light blue squares.

Match two of each color combination: white + light blue, white + background and light blue + background. Sew a quarter inch from BOTH sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line, press and trim the HSTs to 3-1/2". Make 16 HSTs of each color combination.

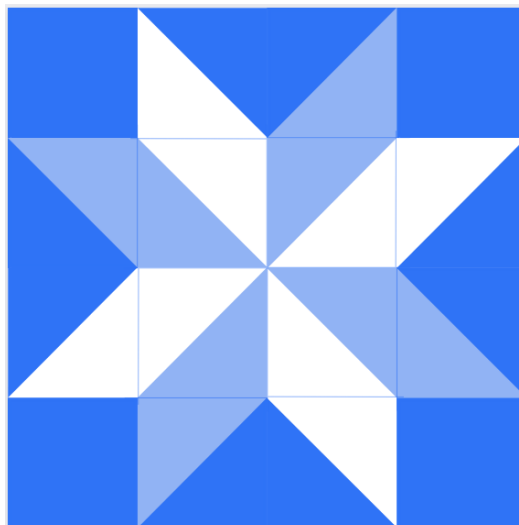
When all HSTs are ready, cut 16 background squares at 3-1/2".

Lay out the squares according to the diagram, keeping colors matched.

Sew the block in 4 quadrants.



Make 4 LeMoyne Star blocks.



Block 2 - Friendship Star

Make 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " HST using the two-at-a-time method:

Cut 4- $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, 16 each from yellow and blue background fabric

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the yellow squares.

Pair a yellow square with a background square and sew a quarter inch from BOTH sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line, press and trim the HSTs to 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make 32 HST.

Cut 8 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from yellow fabric.

Cut 32 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from blue background fabric.

Layout the block as a nine patch. Be sure the star points rotate around the center square.

Piece in rows, pressing towards the solid squares so that seams will nest.

Make 8 friendship star blocks.

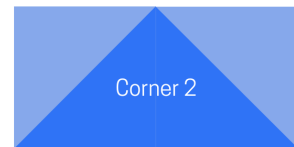
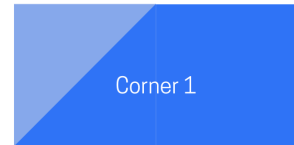


Block 3 - Sawtooth Star

From blue (background), cut 4 squares at 3-½" and 4 rectangles at 3-½" x 6-½".

From light blue, cut 8 squares at 3-½" and one square at 6-½".

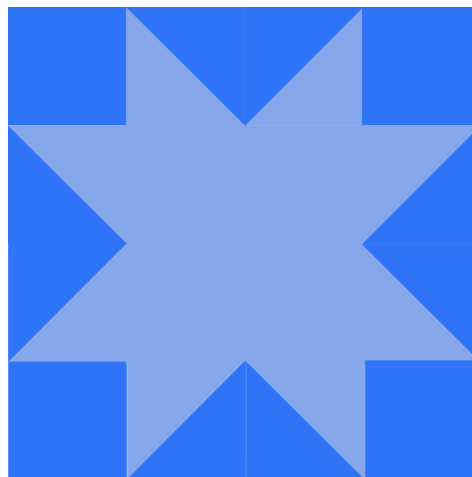
Make flying geese units by placing one light square on the corner of a background rectangle. Sew on the diagonal. Trim ¼" away from the seam, removing excess fabric from behind the light corner and press towards the corner.



Place a second light blue square on the opposite corner and repeat the process to sew on the diagonal and remove excess fabric. Make 4 flying geese units.

Layout the block as a nine patch, with the large square in the center and background squares in the corners. Position the flying geese units so the background points face in towards the center. Sew in rows.

Make one Sawtooth Star block.



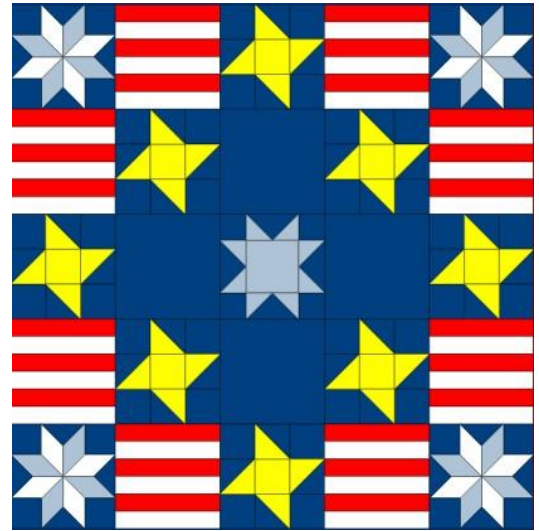
Quilt Layout

Arrange all blocks according to the diagram.
Stripes can run the same way across the quilt in every row, or stay parallel to the edge of the quilt to create a frame.
